The Preschool Waiting List opens at 7:30 a.m. on November 6th, for children who will be four years old by August 31st. Preschool is a private, tuition-based program. Spaces are offered in the order applications are received, with a limited number of half-day positions.



In first grade, the excitement was palpable as the young students embarked on a thrilling journey to learn about plants. Armed with curiosity and small green bean seeds, the classroom was transformed into a mini botanical laboratory. The children gathered around their desks and tables ready to plant with soil, potting cups, and their soon-to-be plant companions. With wide eyes and eager hands, they carefully planted their green bean seeds, each one placing their future plant into the rich, brown soil. The teachers explained the process of germination and the importance of nurturing these tiny seeds into robust green bean plants.

Over the last few weeks, the classrooms have been a bustling hubs of plant-related activities. The first graders observed diagrams and documentation of seeds sprouting into delicate seedlings, and they learned about the essential components of plant growth - water, sunlight, and nutrients. Each day, they dutifully watered their plants and watched with wonder as their green bean plants grew stronger. They learned about photosynthesis and how plants turn sunlight into energy. Their exploration of the plant world not only enriched their scientific knowledge but also nurtured a deep appreciation for the beauty and vitality of the world around them.
